## On November 7, the project's scientific director and key Armenian experts held a meeting in Yerevan. The following topics were discussed, and decisions were made:

- Discussion of land cover data testing results ((<u>https://biodiversity-armenia.com/index.php/seea-ea/ongoing-projects/project-tasks/testing-of-available-landcovers-for-the-territory-of-armenia/</u>): land cover data will be chosen by the end of November.

- Discussion of the progress in digitizing a vegetation map to create a prototype of an updatable ecosystem map for ecosystem accounting: the digital map of ecosystems will be ready by the end of 2024.

- Discussion of data sets available to use in the project: the following materials will be available for use in the project to assess ecosystem services: a) digital maps of soil types; soil carbon stock; river network; precipitation; temperature; b) results of Armenian pasture assessment from ECOserve project of GIZ.
